## EN ESPAÑOL



**Cómo tomar los medicamentos correctamente** - ¿Es usted un buen consumidor de su cuidado de la salud? Una forma de ser un buen consumidor es estar atento y revise sus medicamentos. Lo que usted no sabe puede hacerle daño a usted. Haciendo un seguimiento de sus medicamentos recetados puede

ser un reto. Esto es especialmente cierto si usted está tomando medicamentos recetados por más de un médico para varios problemas médicos. Haga una lista de todos los medicamentos que toma, incluyendo recetas, medicamentos de venta libre, vitaminas y suplementos. Revise su lista de medicamentos con su médico o farmacéutico frecuentemente y especialmente cuando un nuevo medicamento se añade o se elimina. Algunas buenas preguntas son las siguientes: ¿Cómo se llama el medicamento? ¿Por qué necesito la droga? ¿Es un nombre de marca o genérico? ¿Si se trata de una marca, está disponible el equivalente genérico? (Comprando medicamentos genéricos, siempre que sea posible, puede reducir el costo). ¿Debo tomarlo con o sin comida? ¿Debo tomar en cualquier momento particular del día o de la noche? ¿Qué debo hacer si me olvido de una dosis? ¿Por cuánto tiempo debo tomarlo? ¿Cuántas recargas se indican? ¿Cuáles son sus efectos secundarios? ¿Hay reacciones que debo sospechar? ¿Hay algo que debo informar a mi médico? ¿Se interactuar de manera dañina con otros medicamentos que tomo? ¿Cómo debo guardarlo? ¿Hay otras instrucciones especiales? ¿Cuándo se vence? ¿Hay información disponible por escrito? Además, mantenga una copia actualizada de su información médica, incluyendo los contactos de emergencia, su médico, farmacia, y las alergias junto con la información del seguro por lo que este siempre a mano.
