## SOCIAL MINISTRY

**COLLECTING HAND TOWELS** - Help us collect new, small, terry cloth hand towels (16"x27" - small enough to fit in a backpack) to give to our homeless friends. People living without housing must use the public showers at the two downtown shelters. They must provide their own towels, as such items are beyond the shelters' resources. Please bring donations to Sr. Elizabeth the parish office. Towels will be distributed via Mary House Catholic Worker volunteers.

One hundred nine clients came to the **HELPING HAND CRISIS MINISTRY OF SPICEWOOD** during May requesting food assistance for their 270 family members. Eight of these clients were first-time visitors. Seventy-seven families received financial assistance totaling \$7,310. Thirty-three percent of the financial assistance was to help with housing costs, twenty-six percent for transportation and communication expenses with the remaining forty-one percent for dental and medical expenses. The cost for food and personal hygiene products totaled \$1,516. Ministry operating expenses totaled \$512. Expenditures totaled \$9,338 and donations totaled \$11,466. At month's end, the Oak Hill RV was vacant while the Vista House was occupied by a family who would otherwise be homeless. May God continue to bless this ministry and all who make it possible.

**LAKE SAFETY TIPS** - Now that Lake Travis has water and many will be resuming water and boating activities, it is important that everyone keep safe while having fun!

1. Active supervision is the best protection. It is recommended that you assign an adult to be the Water Watcher responsible for supervising children in the water at all times. Floating devices should complement adult supervision, not replace it.
2. Texas law mandates that children younger than 13 must wear a U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) approved personal flotation device (PFD) whenever the boat is underway. The definition of "underway" is any boat that is not anchored, tied up to a dock, or beached. You will know if the PFD fits properly if it cannot slip above the ears when lifted at the shoulders.
3. Only swim in designated swimming areas. If you let your children swim in the open water, it may be difficult for other boaters to see them.
4. Reach or throw, don't go. If you see someone struggling in the water, instead of swimming out to help them, find a flotation device to throw to them or extend a pole or a tree branch that they can grab.
