These ministers should be active and full participants in the celebration with the understanding that they are leaders of the assembly. Eucharistic Ministers must be in good standing in the Church. They set an example for the congregation through prayer, song, and silence. Participation in one or more of the many opportunities for adult formation or prayer ministries is expected. A two-hour training session is required. Time commitment is variable.
