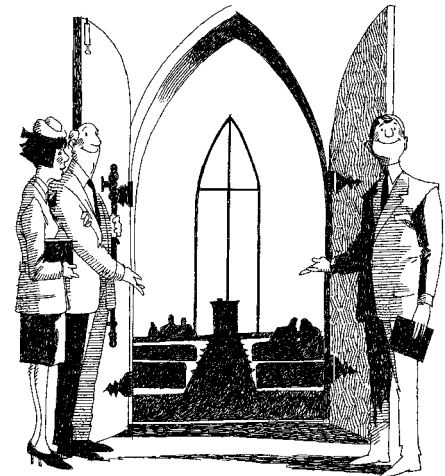
FOCUS ON MINISTRY

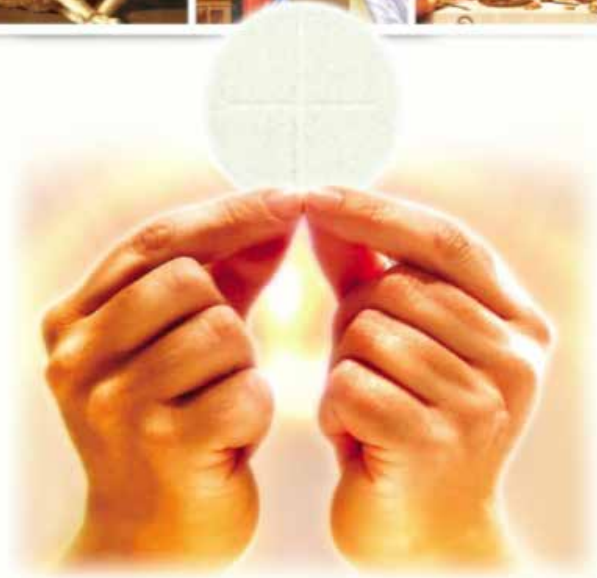
