PREVENTING COLDS & FLU - Winter is cold & flu season. What can you do to try and stay healthy?

- Wash your hands! Use soap, water and friction and wash your hands for as long as it takes to say The Lord's Prayer.
 - Don't touch your face. The only way germs get there is if you put them there!
 - Don't stop sneezes with your hands. Use a tissue and throw it out or sneeze into your sleeve.
 - Drink plenty of fluids, especially water, to keep hydrated and flush out toxins.
 - Get aerobic exercise. It enhances the immune system.
 - Avoid smoking. Smoking zaps the immune system, dries out the nasal passages, and paralyzes cilia that clean the respiratory system.
 - Get plenty of rest!
 - If you feel ill with a cough, fever, achy joints, etc., do yourself a favor and stay home.
 - Remember, there are some people around you that may have a depressed immune system such as those on chemotherapy, young children, elderly, or those with other medical illness that cannot fight infection as well as a healthy person can.
