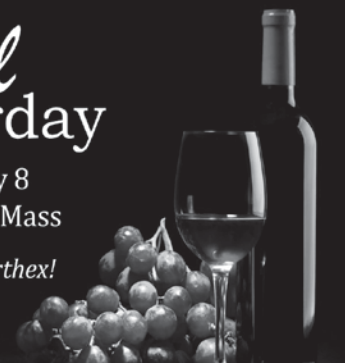

He was ordained a priest on July 2, 2005. He belongs to the Diocese of Estelí. After a year of being ordained, he was sent to the Diocese of Austin for five years. He served at Christ the King in Austin, Ascension in Bastrop, and Santa Cruz in Buda. He has been serving in the Archdiocese of New York for five years at Our Lady of Refuge Parish in the Bronx. Now again he is preparing to begin a new experience at Emmaus Catholic Parish in the Diocese of Austin, which he considers his home. Father Rito says that with trust in God and the prayers of the faithful, he wishes to serve his new community assigned to him by the Bishops of Austin, Joe Vásquez and Daniel García.

Sacerdote fue enviado a la Diócesis de Austin por cinco años.

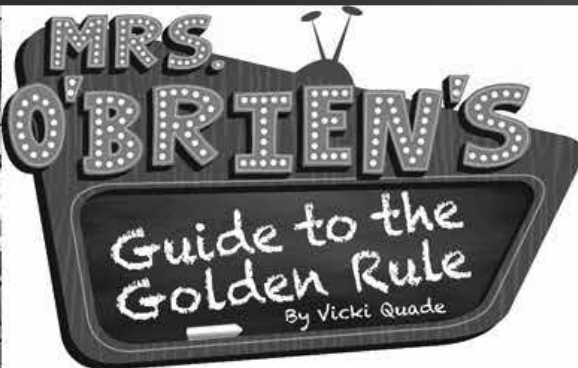
