Capital Campaign Update:

Total in hand: \$1,159,370 - 66% of our mid-point goal of \$1.75M so we can hire an architect and begin the project. Participants: 363 Families have contributed and pledged so far, 14.5% of our parish families.
• November 30 is the last day that our campaign donations are not subject to the Diocesan assessment (the cathedraticum). Anything we receive after that date will be divided, 90% to Emmaus and 10% to the Diocese.
• October 31, 2020 is the end of the three year campaign. This is the date on which we hope to have raised the complete \$3.725 Million and have no loans to pay.
